Overview - Horizon 2020 Science with and for Society - Responsible Research and Innovation related resources and initiatives in Flanders and beyond

Introduction

In Horizon 2020, the Science with and for Society (Swafs) programme has the aim to contribute to the promotion of Responsible Research and Innovation (RRI): "societal actors work together during the whole research and innovation process in order to better align both the process and its outcomes, with the values, needs and expectations of European society."¹ Under this concept a number of subjects are defined, which served as inspiration to structure this overview of resources.

In Flanders many initiatives in these various Swafs and RRI areas take place, in collaboration with scientists based at Flemish (research) institutions or with citizens living in Flanders, and they are often publicly available - in English and/or Dutch. This document takes stock of the resources, research and practices over the last years. On top of the Flemish initiatives, also Horizon 2020 proposal and project requirements and European initiatives are included in the overview. It is by no means (yet) an exhaustive overview and therefore it will be continuously updated with future developments.

Under Horizon Europe, the successor programme to H2020, the Science with and for Society programme as such no longer exists, but as under Horizon 2020, the different subjects that fall under this umbrella are being continued as cross-cutting issues, and are thus being promoted throughout Horizon Europe. Furthermore, a majority of the topics are being continued under the Horizon Europe "Strengthening the ERA" subprogramme part.
